

## PUBLIC NOTICE

4.2

The COMPTON WATERWORKS is a public water system subject to regulation under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Those regulations require the notification of customers whenever a violation occurs, and is the basis for this notice.

The monthly Bacteriological Monitoring and Operations Reports are required to be submitted to the State by the 10th day of the following month. This requirement was not met for August 2020.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sets standards for drinking water. Public water systems are required to regularly have their water bacteriologically tested in a certified laboratory. These samples are analyzed for Total Coliform and E.Coli bacteria. Coliform bacteria is used as an indicator for more serious pathogenic organisms.

Failure to meet this requirement does not necessarily mean that the water is unsafe or that alternate sources of water should be used.
